## Seminar description

In the winter semester 2021/22, the Universities of Freiburg and Strasbourg, in cooperation and as members of European Campus, will offer the Master's seminar "Transformative Leadership: A sustainable leadership model for values-based organizations".

The aim of the seminar is to provide theoretical and practical insights into the field of leadership in public, non-profit and value-based organizations and to discuss leadership topics in an interdisciplinary, international environment. The seminar consists of a combination of classroom sessions at the two locations, online modules and a so-called "shadowing phase", in which students have the unique opportunity to accompany managers from practice. In the seminar, participants develop the theoretical foundations necessary for understanding the topic, gain insights into the everyday life of executives from non-profit organizations through direct contact with them, and work on a case study on the topic of business ethics.

- Shadowing" with managers from practice (approx. 3 days, flexibly divided and agreed directly with managers at the first meeting). Due to the ongoing Corona situation, an alternative is offered for students who are not able to attend the shadowing in presence.
- E-portfolio as a final thesis
